Before I explain the Book Bizarre, let me give you a few tips on buying used books.

1. Always check the booklist before buying anything new or used. Make sure we are still using the text before you buy it.
2. Try to buy used books before registering, if possible. Use your carpool sheet to contact students who may have books you need.
3. If you plan to buy or sell used books on registration days, come early. It's a seller's market.
4. The bookstore does not buy or sell used books. All transactions are between the buyer and seller.

Now, to the Book Bizarre. In an attempt to bring some order out of the chaos of buying used books, the Student Council will try to bring buyers and sellers together. On August 12, 2009 Prep and Freshman will register. Freshmen and Prep year, go to the auditorium.

On August 13, Sophomores, Juniors, and Seniors will register. If you wish to buy or sell books, go to the auditorium.

Note: Sophomores who wish to sell books should bring them to school on the 12th and go to the auditorium.

On both days, members of Student Council will be in the auditorium to bring buyers and sellers together.
