STANDARDIZED TEST PREPARATION

REMINDER TO JUNIORS: We strongly recommend that you plan to take BOTH the SAT and ACT with Writing by June 2012. BUT, as part of the District Choice State Testing, you will be required to take the ACT (without Writing) on March 20 at school.

Also, start looking to see if any schools you have interest in will require SAT II Subject Test scores so you can plan your testing schedule ahead of time.

(3) JUNIORS: I am currently working through the junior class during your study halls. During these meetings I am reviewing the college application process, what you should be doing the remainder of this year to stay on top of things and giving information about standardized testing. If you want to meet sooner, rather than later, please see me so I can schedule you.

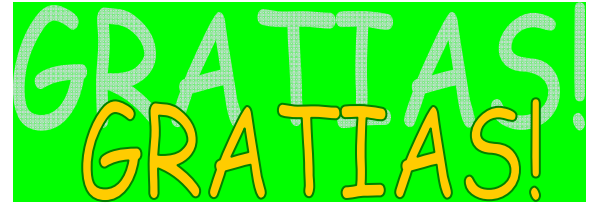
